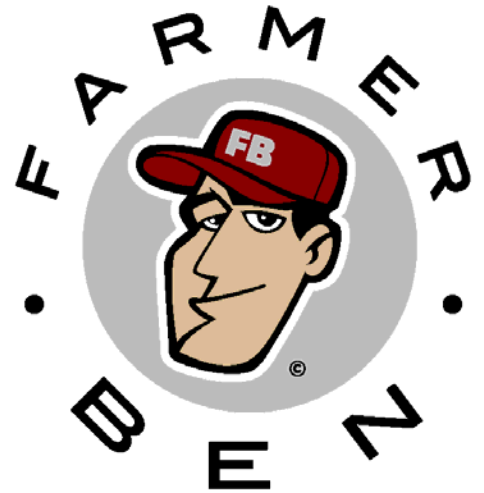


Pine Cone Trees

Virginia Pines are a variety grown in the Appalachian and Piedmont regions of the southeastern US. Pine trees have both male and female cones. The male cones produce pollen which blows through the air. The female cones house the seed which takes two years to mature.



You will need:

Pinecones
School glue
Assorted glitter
Gallon-size baggies
Cotton balls

How to:

1. Shake glitter into plastic bag.
2. Drizzle glue all over pinecone.
3. Place pinecone in bag and shake until covered with glitter.
4. Let dry, then glue cotton balls to bottom to act as snowy base.

Variation:

Glue individual embellishments to the tips of the pine cone.
